Two bands will be moving through the crowds without any power supply, stage or music stands, providing laid-back musical entertainment. Visitors to the event can look forward to mobile musical entertainment in a broad range of styles with a high level of musical craft.

The Red Socks Brassquintett - one of Germany's most successful brass ensembles

The Red Socks Brassquintett is a professional brass quintet comprising two trumpets, one horn, a trombone and a tuba. Formed in November 2010, the members of The Red Socks Brassquintett have all studied under renowned instrumental professors and cultivate a top-quality brand of brass chamber music. Their entertaining set ranges from baroque compositions to film scores. The Bavarian radio station Bayerischer Rundfunk has broad-cast a number of the quintets performances, most recently as part of its BR 4 classical programmes. The five musicians also have also been hired to perform for the Bavarian state government, for State Minister Dr. Wolfgang Heubisch and for Bavarian Minister-President Horst Seehofer.

Trio Triplo – professional, authentic performances of traditional folk music from the entire Alpine region for accordion, guitar and double bass

Benedikt Landenhammer (guitar), Andreas Weiß (accordion) and Dominik Billinger (double bass) met while collaborating on a range of performances as part of several different line-ups. The music of the ensemble resonates with a sense of joy, featuring compositions based on international and religious themes. Their music is notable for its unique, unmistakable sound. In terms of successes, they have been awarded the highest distinction at the biennial Alpine Folk Music Competition. Furthermore, the trio have appeared on a host of Bayerischer Rundfunk's (Bavarian radio) live radio programmes.
